

# Kirby Grindalythe Residents Meeting

**Monday 16<sup>th</sup> November 2015 at 7pm**

### 1. Introduction

Keith Acomb introduced the members of the Parish Council. He explained that in June 2015 all villagers were requested to submit suggestions to the Parish Council in respect of the 106 Agreement Fund of £8755. A list of the suggestions received were handed out.

### 2. List of suggestions discussed

Barbara Crompton presented the suggestions (see list below) and a discussion followed.

- The planting around the village signs has been completed with funds from the Hogg Houses Management Company and the Parish Council but these areas will need to be maintained. This maintenance could be taken over by John Brown who currently cuts the church grass.
- Play Area – there is no public land available in the village to put a play area and the insurance and maintenance would be expensive.
- Main Street – perhaps not remove the grass bank but edge it properly with a curb. There is always problems with parking when events are held. The curbs would be damaged by vehicles.
- Enhancements to the Hogg Developments entrances this could be covered by the PC. The residents have planted these areas themselves and it looks very attractive.
- Additional item – donation to the church for the electrical work. Ryedale Council may not agree to this type of project for this particular funding.
- Canopy for the Village Hall and improve the outside floor – the right of way would have to be maintained. The Village Hall is used by the community and is a central part of the village.
- Renovate the Lynch Gate - the church is aware that it needs repairing and it should be addressed in Phase III of the repairs.

### 3. Outcome of discussion.

It was suggested that the money be split between the church electrics and the village hall canopy. The canopy will need to be costed. The project will need to be referred back to Ryedale Council to see if they will release the funds. A vote was taken on the two agreed options:

Option 1 – Village Hall canopy project and any remaining funds to the church.

Option 2 – Even split of the funds between the village hall and the church.
